Do I have to wear a helmet?

Yes.

Weather?

THASKELL

We ride rain or shine. However, we have a comprehensive weather safety plan.

What kind of road support is provided?

Our route is fully supported. There are rest stops every 10-15 miles, refreshments, restrooms, SAG vehicles, medical staff and bicycle repair vans.

What is SAG?

Safety and Gear vehicles will be on the route all day to pick up weary or injured cyclists. SAG will take you to the closest rest stop. SAG will not take you directly to the finish line.

When will I get a copy of the route?

Ride with GPS links are available at **bikems.org**. Turn by turn directions will also be available at the registration tent the morning of the ride.

Can my family ride along the route with me in their car?

No, but they can meet you at the finish line on Day 1 and Day 2.

FAQs

Can my friends and family eat with me?

Absolutely! Meal and beverage wristbands for non-cyclists will be available for purchase for \$20 at the customer service tent on Saturday in Daytona Beach.

Where is the customer service tent in Daytona located?

The customer service tent is located directly outside the entrance of the bandshell and Team Village area outside of the Hilton.

Are massages available?

Yes, massages are available and cost \$1 per minute. You may purchase as many minutes as you like. Massage tables will be inside of the Hilton Daytona Beach Resort on Saturday and both finish lines (Northeast Florida Regional Airport & Marineland) on Sunday. Cash or Card accepted at all locations.

Can someone else pick up my packet at check-in? Yes, as long as you have met your \$250 fundraising minimum.

What time do the One Way One Day shuttles leave? Marineland: The shuttle to Marineland will leave at 2 and 8:30

p.m. on Saturday from the Hilton Daytona Beach Resort.

Northeast Florida Regional Airport: The shuttle to Northeast Florida Regional Airport will leave at 4:30 and 8:30 p.m. on Saturday from the Hilton Daytona Beach Resort.

Participants must request a shuttle seat upon registration. If you have not reserved a shuttle seat you can add your name to the first come, first serve waiting list at the customer service tent in Daytona on Saturday. Available seats are \$20 and are LIMITED.


